

# City of Westport, Mayor Bearden **EXECUTIVE ORDER**



**WHEREAS**, the City of Westport Mayor and City Council passed Ordinance 1633 on April 13, 2020 directing all commercial lodging facilities including, but not limited to, transient vacation rental homes, hotels, motel, condominiums, RV Parks, campgrounds, private property being used as campgrounds, and any other transient rental businesses shall immediately close and remain closed until further Executive Order by the Westport Mayor; and

**WHEREAS**, the Westport Mayor and City Council heard numerous letters of testimony for and against the re-opening of lodging, transient vacation rental homes, RV Parks, etc. at their regular council meeting on May 21, 2020 through zoom; and

**WHEREAS**, the Westport Mayor and City Council have taken into consideration the public's testimony, Grays Harbor County Commissioners' application for early advancement to the Governor's phased plan, and safety of its citizens, businesses, and visitors, and

**WHEREAS**, the Westport City Council voted to open all commercial lodging facilities including, but not limited to, transient vacation rental homes, hotels, motel, condominiums, RV Parks, campgrounds, private property being used as campgrounds, and any other transient rental businesses at their regular meeting held May 21, 2020;


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDERED BY** the Mayor of the City of Westport, Grays Harbor County, Washington, as follows:

Section 1. That the restrictions of Ordinance 1633 directing all commercial lodging facilities including, but not limited to, transient vacation rental homes, hotels, motel, condominiums, RV Parks, campgrounds, private property being used as campgrounds, and any other transient rental businesses are rescinded effective May 22, 2020 for all commercial lodging facilities so long as commercial lodging facilities comply with section 2 below.

Section 2. All commercial lodging facilities including, but not limited to, transient vacation rental homes, hotels, motel, condominiums, RV Parks, campgrounds, private property being used as campgrounds, and any other transient rental businesses shall provide a declaration to the City of Westport Clerk-Treasurer (or designee) that they have in place CDC and Washington State safety guidelines for the COVID-19 pandemic.

Section 3. This order may be amended in the future as circumstances developed as determined by the Mayor of the City of Westport.
