Dear City of Westport Water Customer:

The City of Westport's water system has the responsibility to deliver water to its consumers that meets all health standards in the Safe Drinking Water Act and the Washington State Drinking Water Regulations for Group A systems (Chapter 246-290 WAC).

Washington State drinking water regulations, WAC 246-290-490, require public water systems to develop and implement Cross-Connection Control (CCC) Programs. Cross-Connection Control programs help protect public health by preventing contamination of the drinking water as it is delivered to water system customers. The enclosed information explains what a cross-connection is, describes typical household cross-connections and what you can do to help protect your drinking water.

Enclosed is a Survey Report Form for the City of Westport's Residential Cross Connection Control Program; which needs to be filled out and returned to the Water Department.

By state law the City of Westport must consider that you may pose a potential cross connection hazard to the City's drinking water system. Until we are able to determine otherwise, this determination can only be made once we have received your completed Residential Survey Report Form and the City's Cross Connection Specialist (CCS) has completed an onsite assessment survey, if required. Following the on-site survey, you may be required to have a backflow preventer, either a Double Check Valve Assembly (DCVA) or a Reduced Pressure Backflow Assembly (RPBA) installed on your service line downstream from your water meter.
