ORDINANCE NO. 1370

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1273 TO UPDATE THE TIME FRAME AND CONDITIONS FOR AUTHORIZING CRAB POT STORAGE IN THE WESTPORT MARINA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTPORT, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Chapter 10.16.330 is repealed in its entirety and replaced with the following:

10.16.330 Crab Pot Staging May be Authorized. The Mayor or his designee may authorize, with certain conditions, crab pot staging in specific areas along Neddie Rose Drive, Lot 27, First Addition of Westhaven, and the municipal parking lots; Lots 7 of Blocks 6, 7, and 8, First Addition of Westhaven; subject to the following conditions,


- (1) Staging may be authorized during the months of September through January.
- (2) Staging will not exceed 120 days at any one location.
- (3) The usage must be authorized by written agreement with the user and the City of Westport.
- (4) Staged pots will be clean and not contain any bait or fish/shellfish parts in the pots.
- (5) The user will acknowledge in writing that they are responsible for the proper stacking and location of pots so as not impede or present a danger to vehicular or pedestrian traffic in the area the pots are stored.
- (6) The applicant shall indemnify, defend and hold the City of Westport harmless for any and all claims of every nature regarding said staging.

(7) The Mayor or his designee may (in writing) revoke said authorization at their sole discretion.


